

Carl D. Wootten came with us to Vietnam. He was a Seabee, a builder, a good friend to many people. He was "the tall skinny guy who laughed a lot." In April of 1970 he became a part of a detachment from Camp Haskins sent to install a water system at Thuong Duc, a tiny Special Forces camp in the foothills of the mountains that reach back across Vietnam and into Laos. On May 1, 1970, he died there, a victim of a vicious rocket and mortar attack. He died in a bunker that he selflessly volunteered to defend. His death was not a back page news story nor another slight rise to a statistic. He was one of us. This book is his. He paid for it.

A deployment is many things. MCB 121's third RVN deployment is now a matter of record, of history. The work has been charted and analyzed; formed into neat statistics. The results have been properly recorded and all filed quietly away. This book is for us who were there. For us a deployment is not statistics, but memories . . .

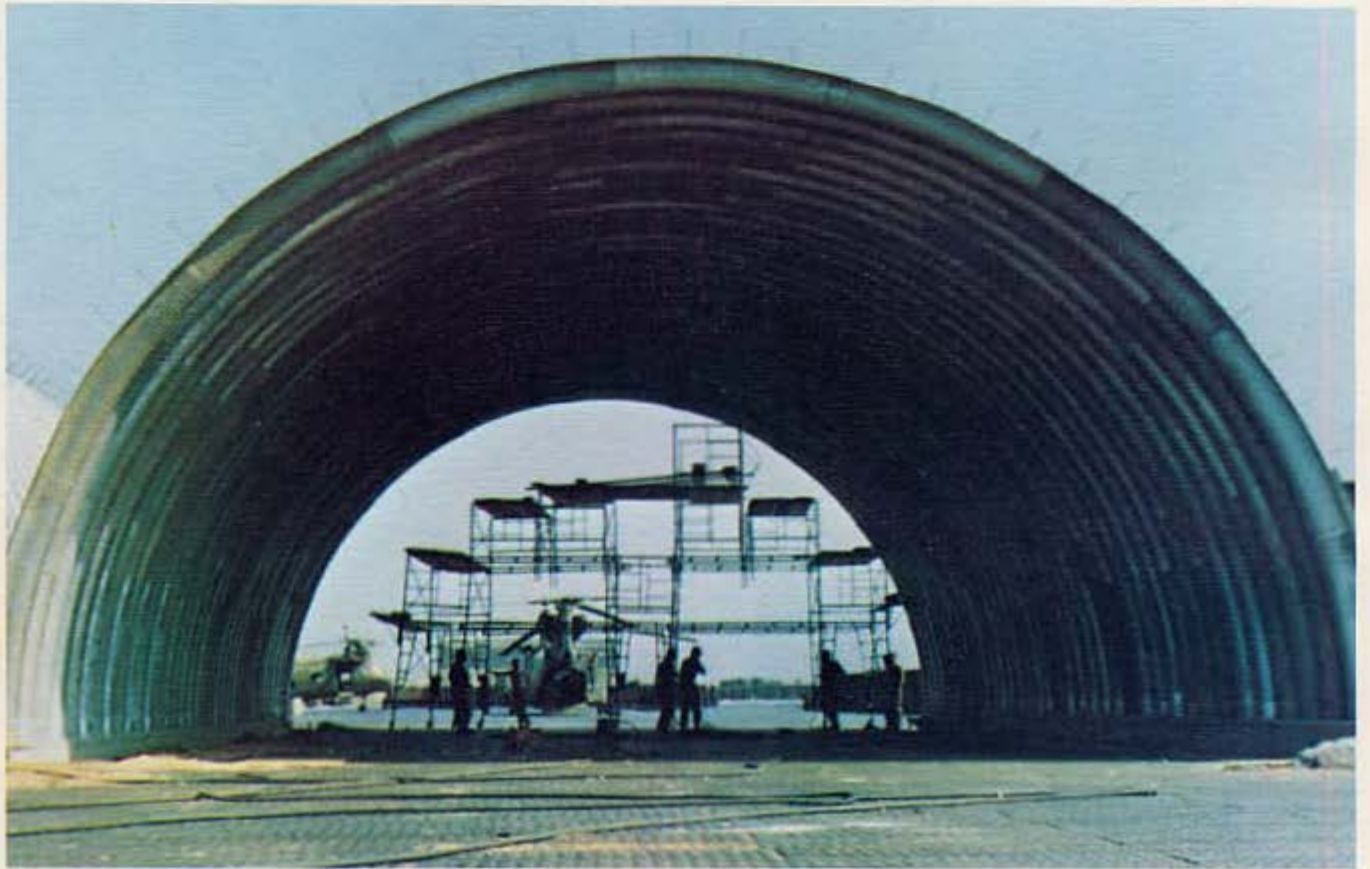

PROJECTS



ROUTE QL-1



The grading, paving and maintaining of QL-1, South Vietnam's main north-south route, was the most valuable accomplishment of the deployment. Alpha Company upgraded and paved 15 miles of highway from the village of Thanh Quit to the hamlet of Tu My, south of Da Nang. North of Camp Haskins both Alpha and Charlie Companies kept busy patching the route and installing headwalls over the Hai Van Pass to Lang Co.

With the enemy around, bridgework on QL-1 was a never ending assignment. Alpha, Charlie, and Delta did emergency repair work on five bridges blown by the enemy. To deter the enemy, we modified Cooper, Nam-O, and Lang Co bridges by installing pier protection and security lighting. We completely built three bridges to help close the Vietnamese communications and supply gap.



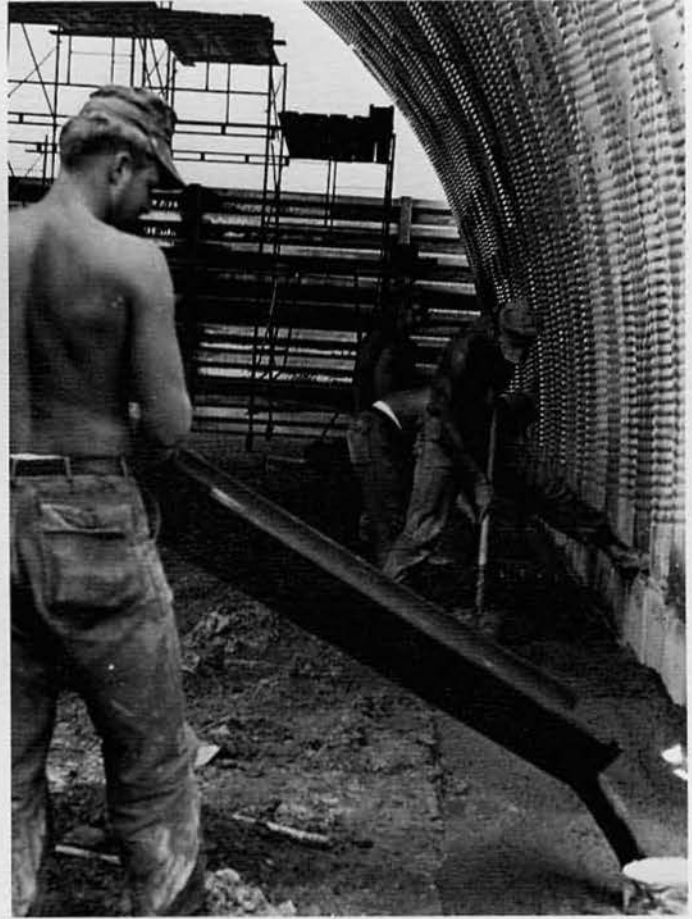
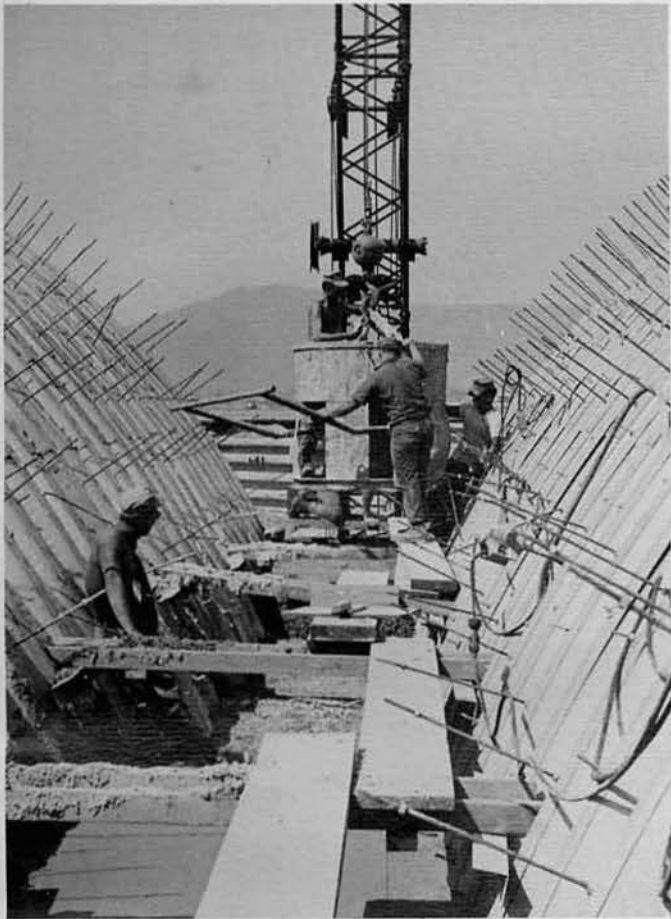
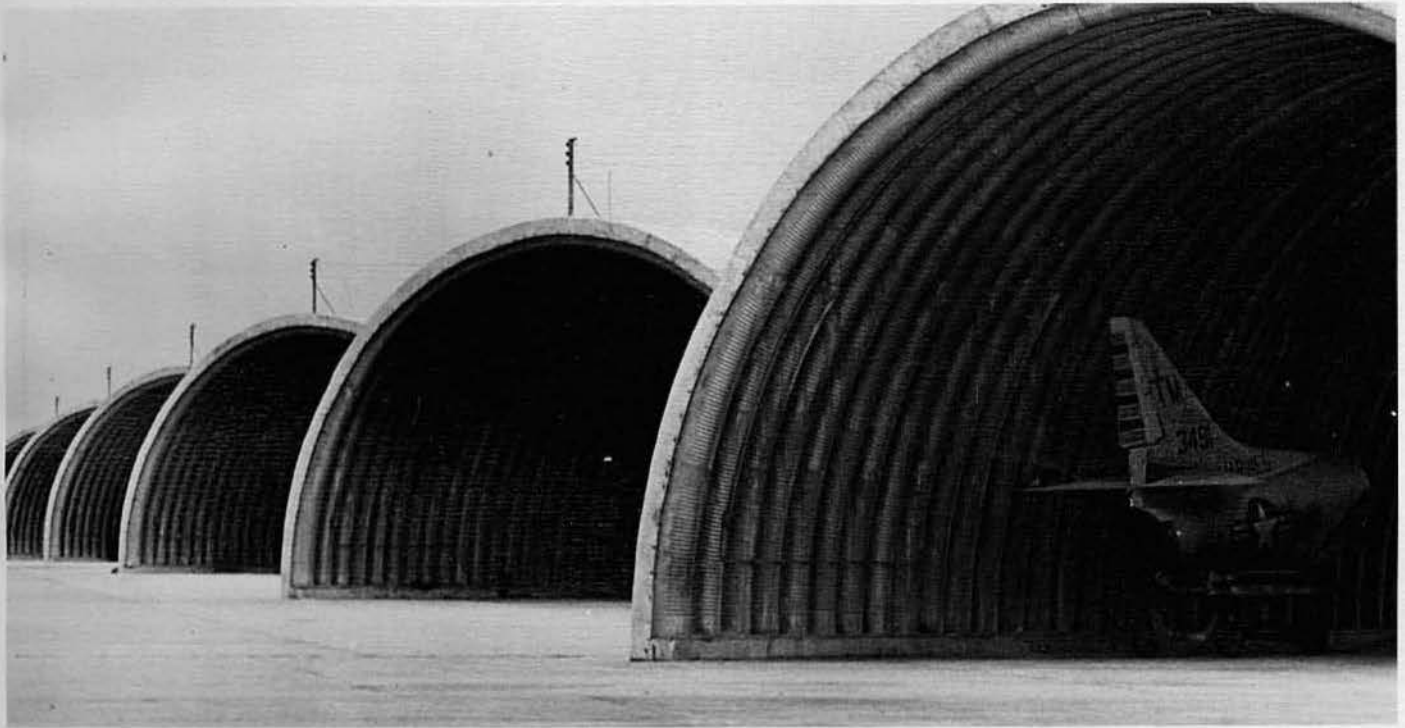


WONDER ARCHES

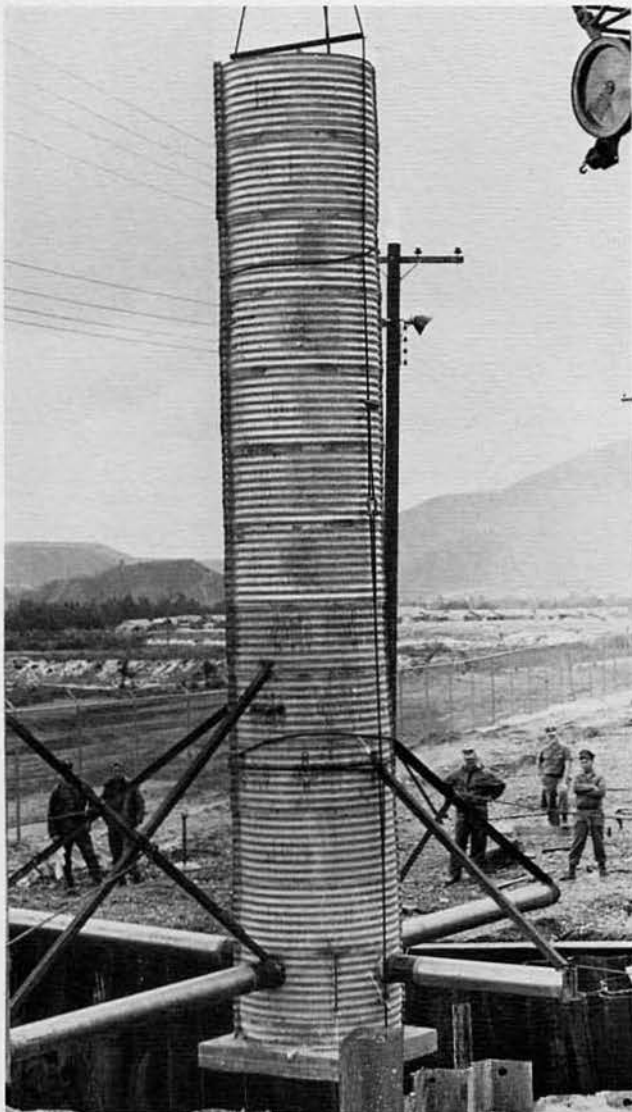
The skyline of Da Nang took on a new look as Delta and Charlie Companies erected 25 aircraft shelters known as Wonder Arches. The arches were constructed of steel panels bolted together and overlaid with 18 inches of concrete. When completed they could withstand the impact of enemy rockets.

To be near the assigned arch construction for Marine Air Group 16, Delta Company and supporting men from Alpha, Bravo, and Hotel Companies took up residence east of Da Nang at Camp Adenir. They became known as Detachment Marble.





FLC RETROGRADE



One of our first projects was to help Marines being pulled out of Vietnam under President Nixon's withdrawal program. We were tasked with constructing a retrograde facility for cleaning, packing, and storing equipment and material for return to the States. Charlie Company erected steel and wood frame buildings. Security towers were prefabricated and flown in by CH-53 helicopters. Bravo Company installed wiring and a water system. Alpha Company graded, paved, and filled a vehicle storage area with hardstand. We worked around the clock and the project was designed, constructed, and occupied in less than eight weeks.



CH-47 HANGARS

The largest wood structures in Vietnam are hangars for CH-47 helicopters. Charlie Company took on the formidable task of constructing two of them for the Army's 58th TC.

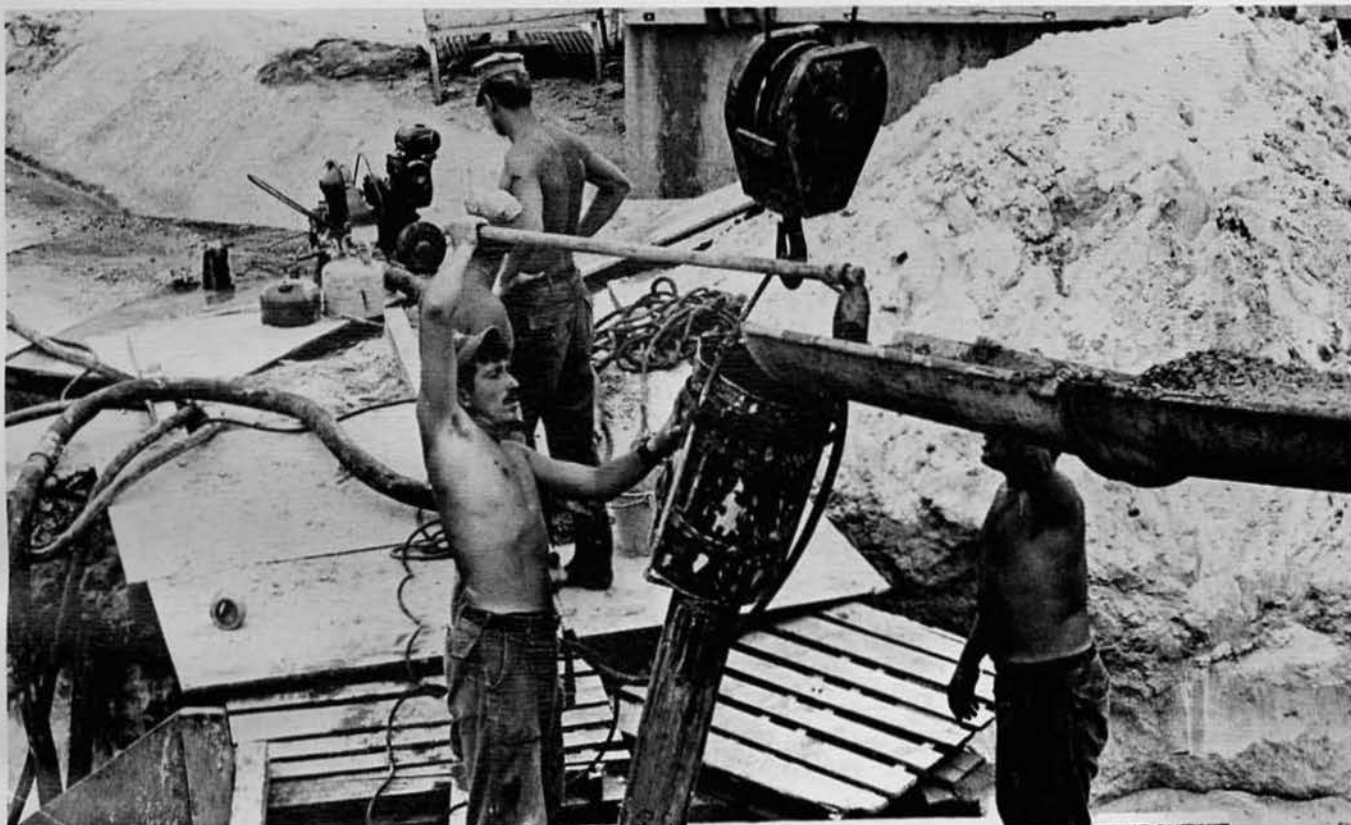

Charlie and Bravo Companies worked long hours renovating three Admin buildings, repairing and setting up trailers for living quarters, constructing hootches, showers, and bunkers. Alpha Company graded and paved a roadway for the new tenants.





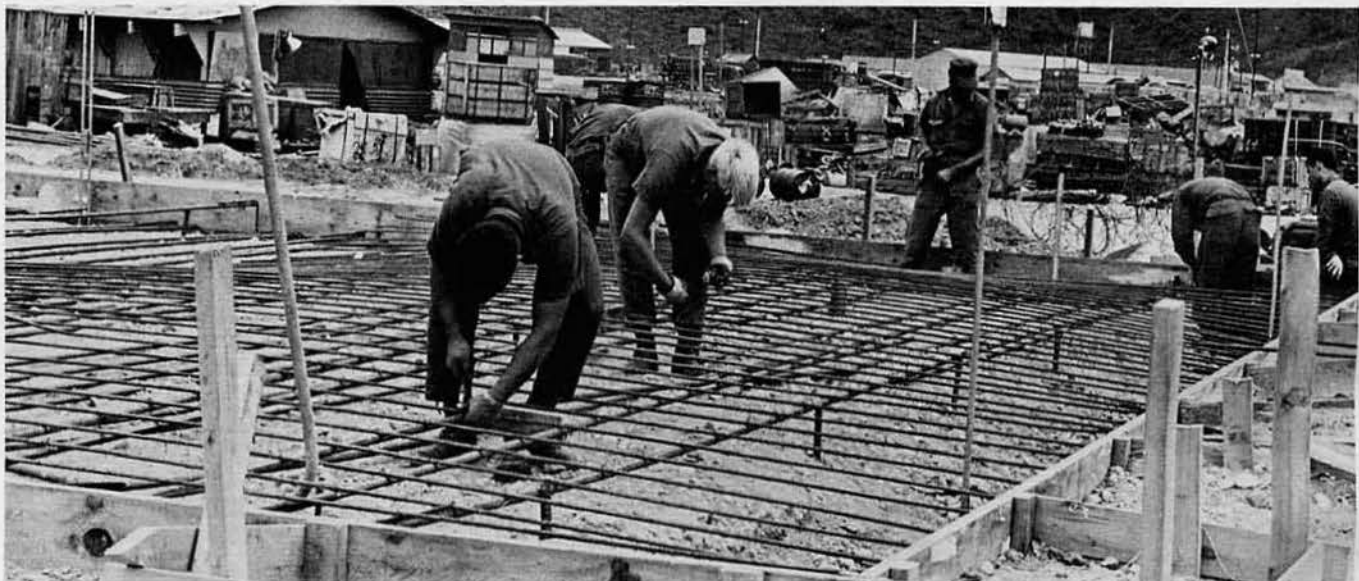
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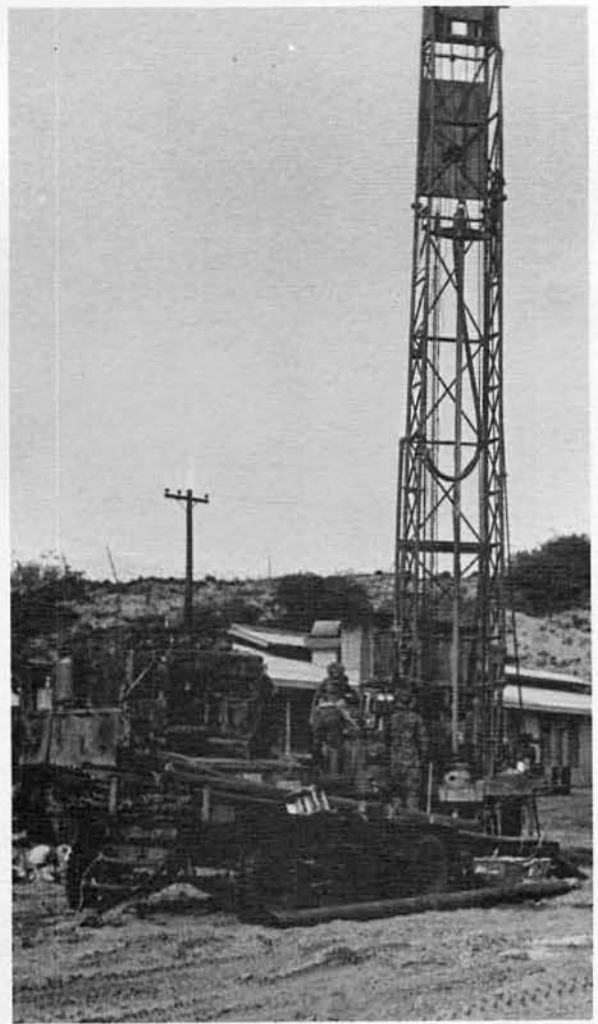
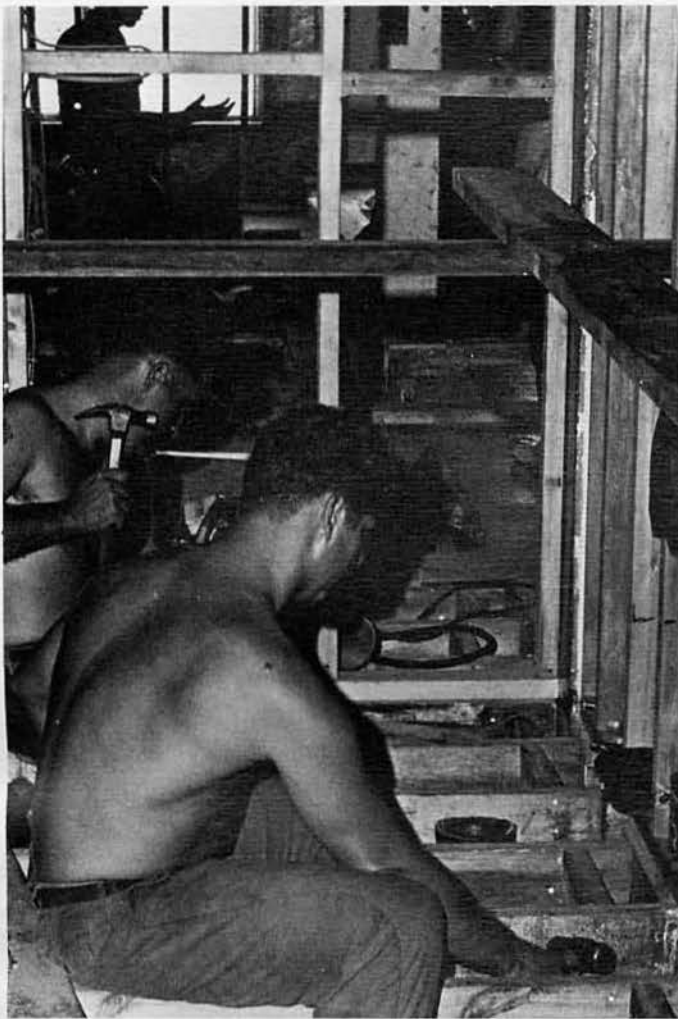
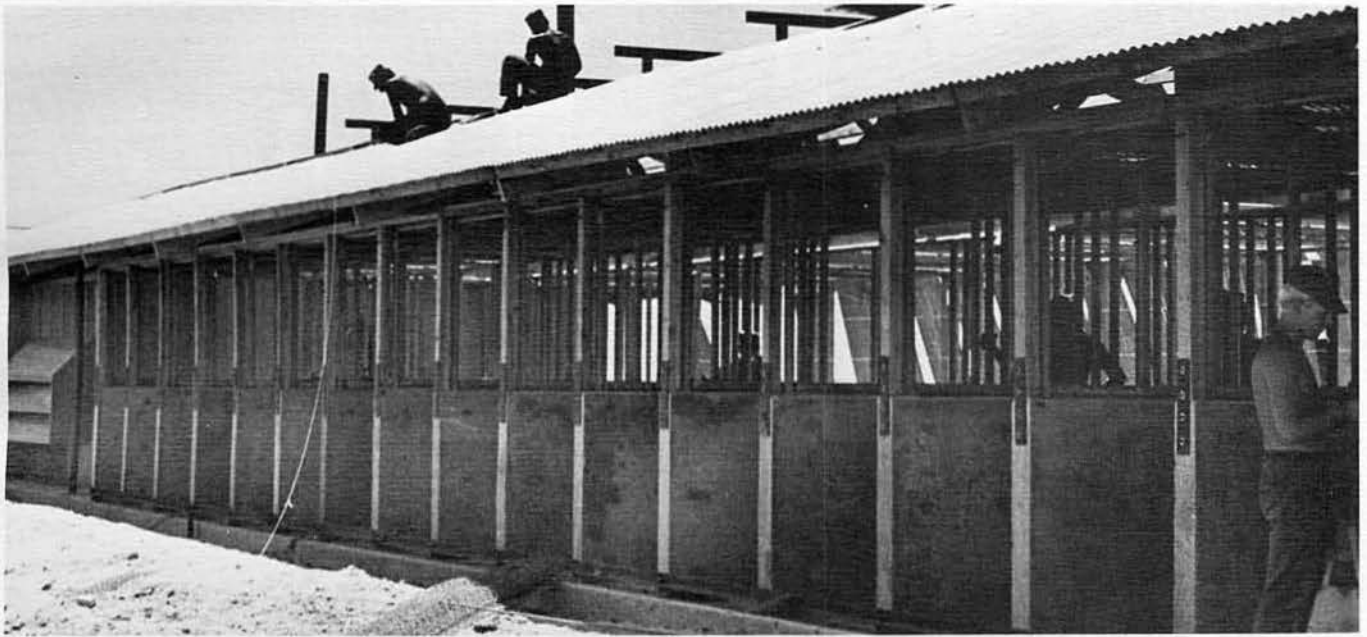
Bravo Company made in-country life flow more smoothly for our Marine neighbors at FLC by finishing the installation of a sewage collection system.



VARIED AND SCATTERED PROJECTS

As the deployment progressed, more and more of our work was of a smaller scope than our initial projects. We were scattered throughout the I Corps. Delta Company constructed a machine shop for the South Vietnamese Small Craft Facility in Da Nang, built messing facilities at both Camp Horn and NSA, and constructed a small retrograde area for the Army's 80th General Support Group. With Bravo Company, Delta built dog kennels for the Army's Canine Corps. Charlie and Bravo Companies sent a 14 man detachment to Thuong Duc to install a water system. Heavy enemy action halted work at the camp before completion. Charlie Company erected a PX for Marine Air Group 11 and worked with Delta Company in building two base camps for ARVN rifle companies. Both Charlie and Alpha sent men on a detachment to Hue to construct ramps for the Thuy Tu Ferry which operates on a local river.

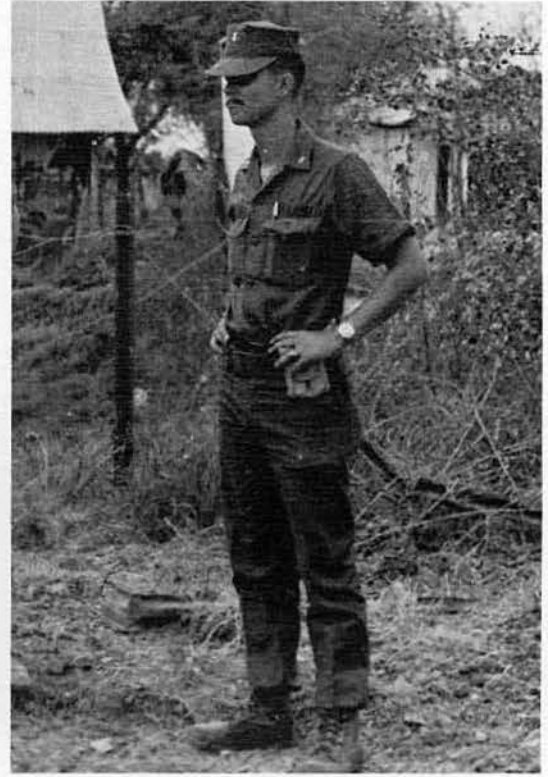




SEABEE TEAM 12103

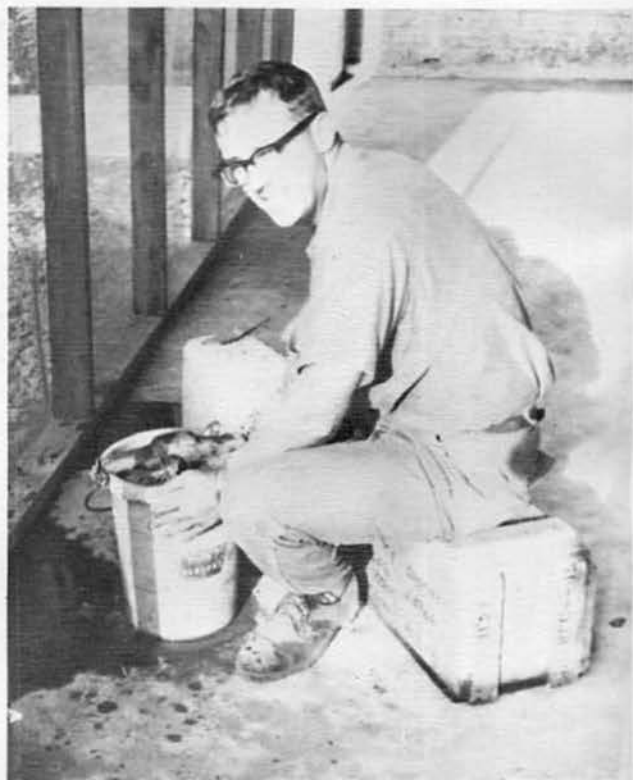

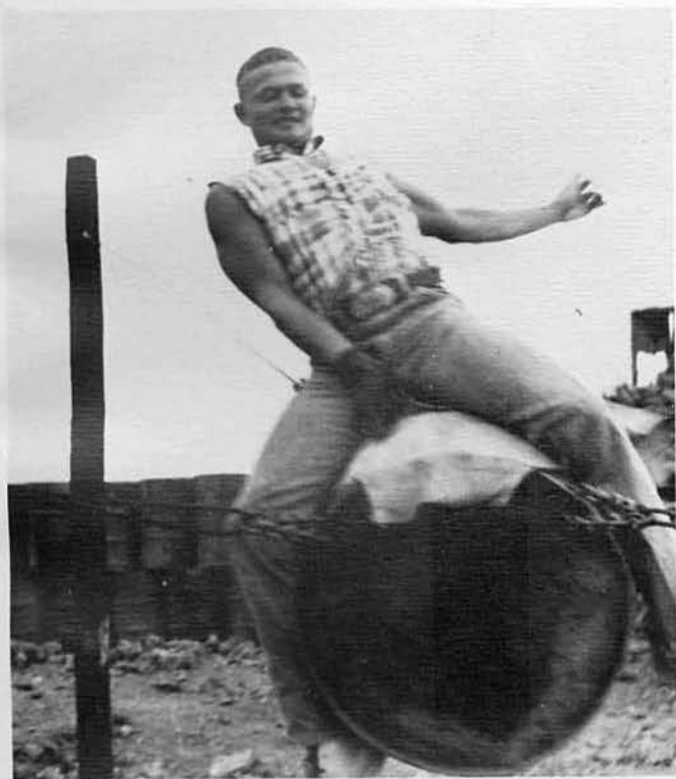


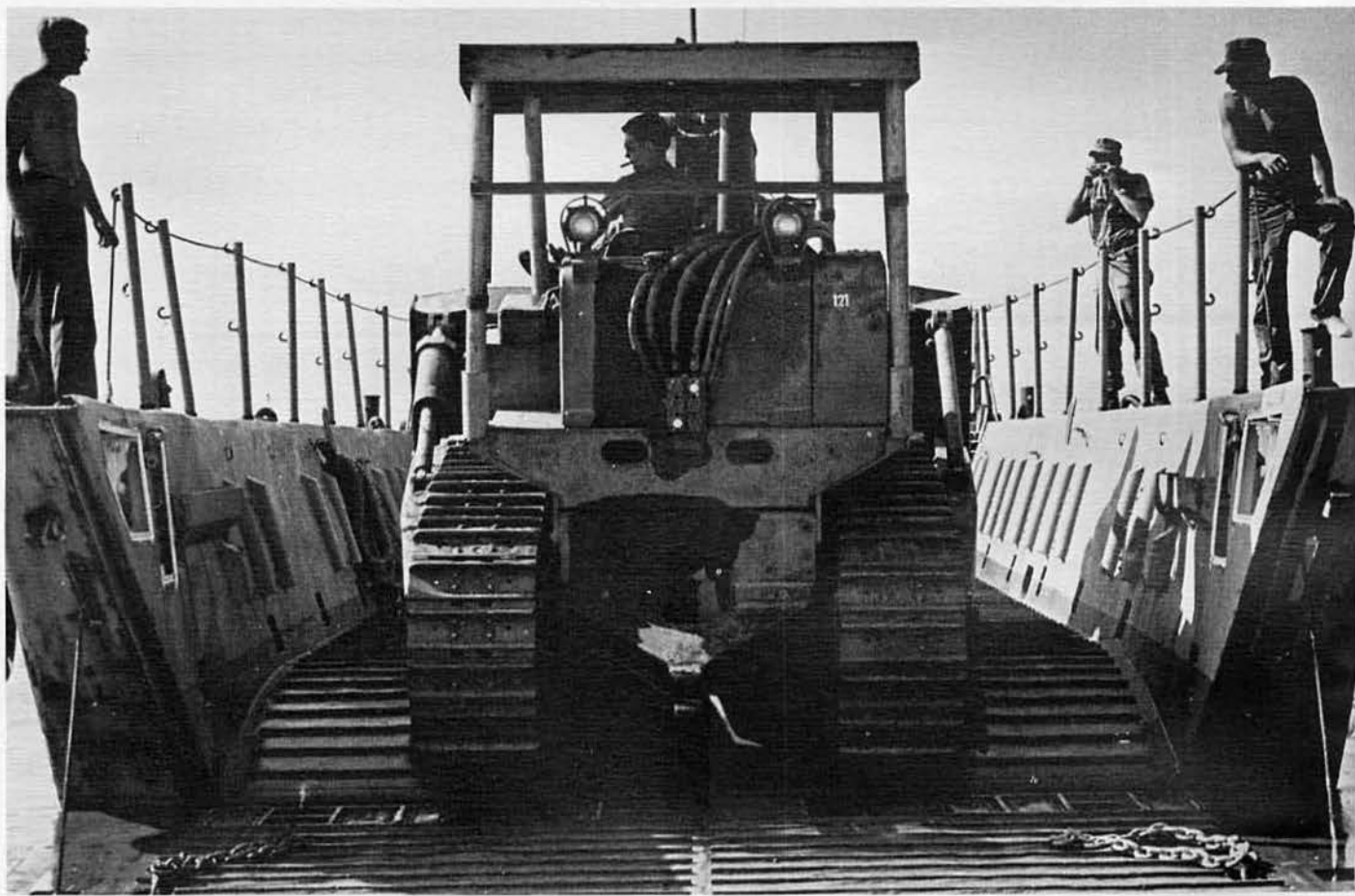
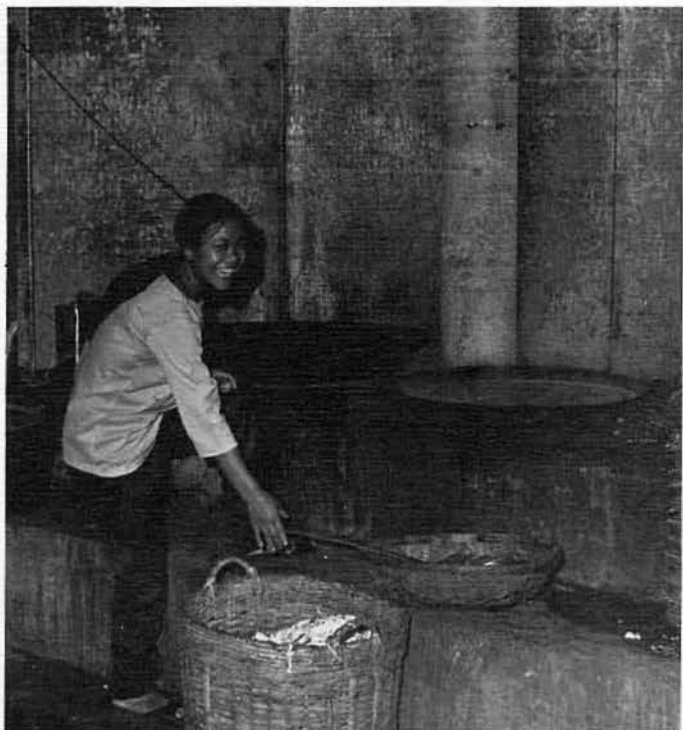


SEABEE TEAM 12104

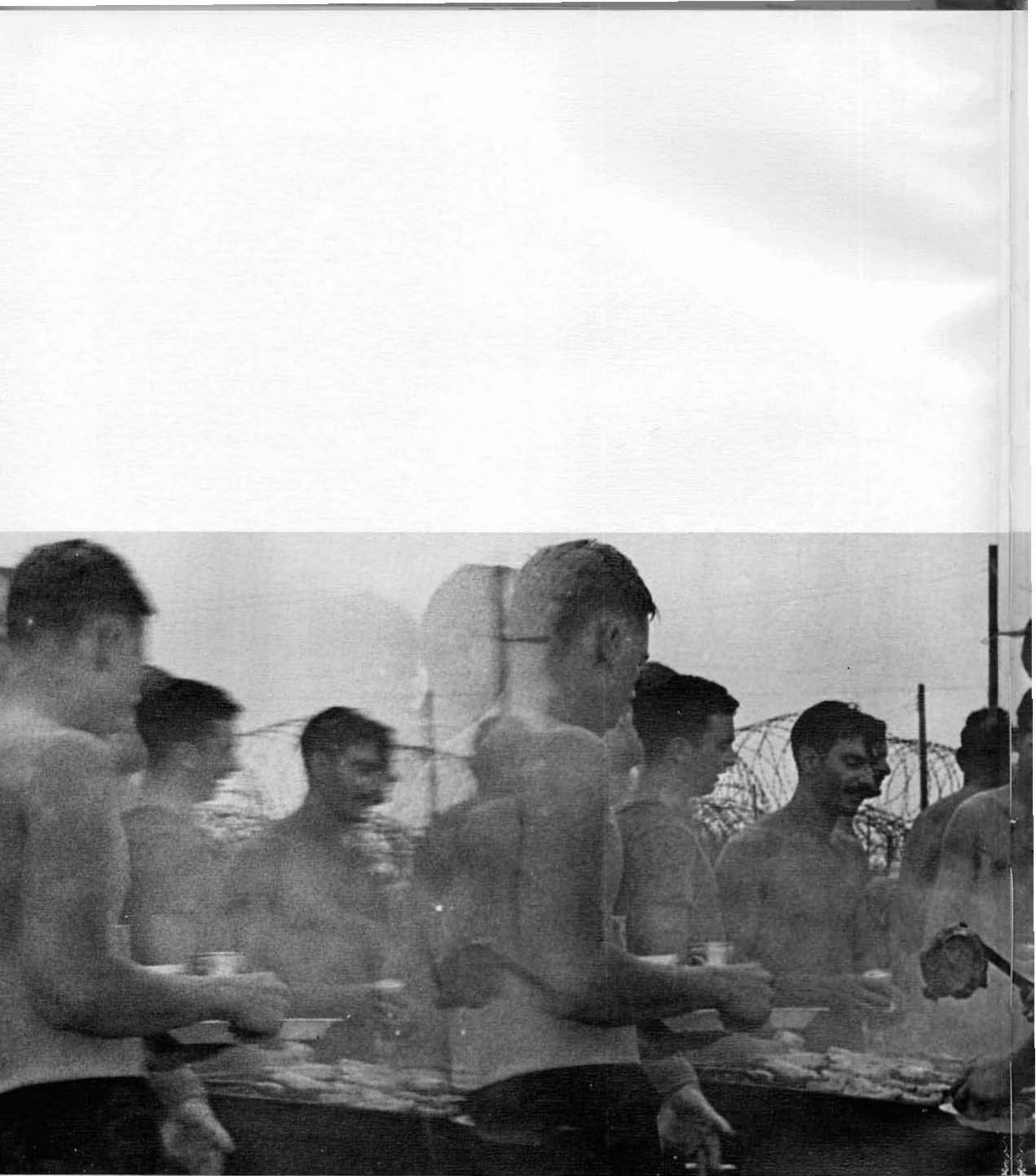




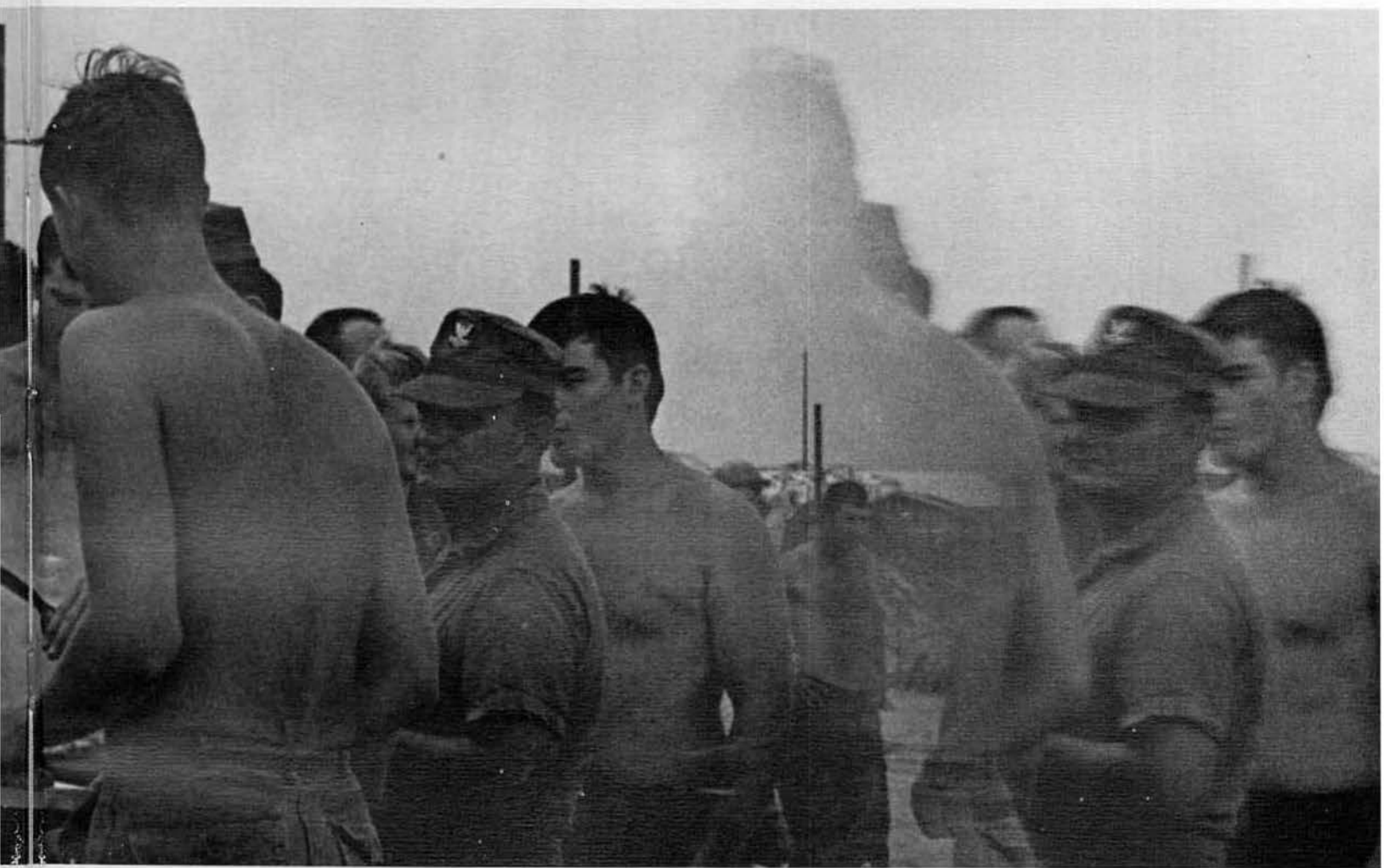
MEDCAP
