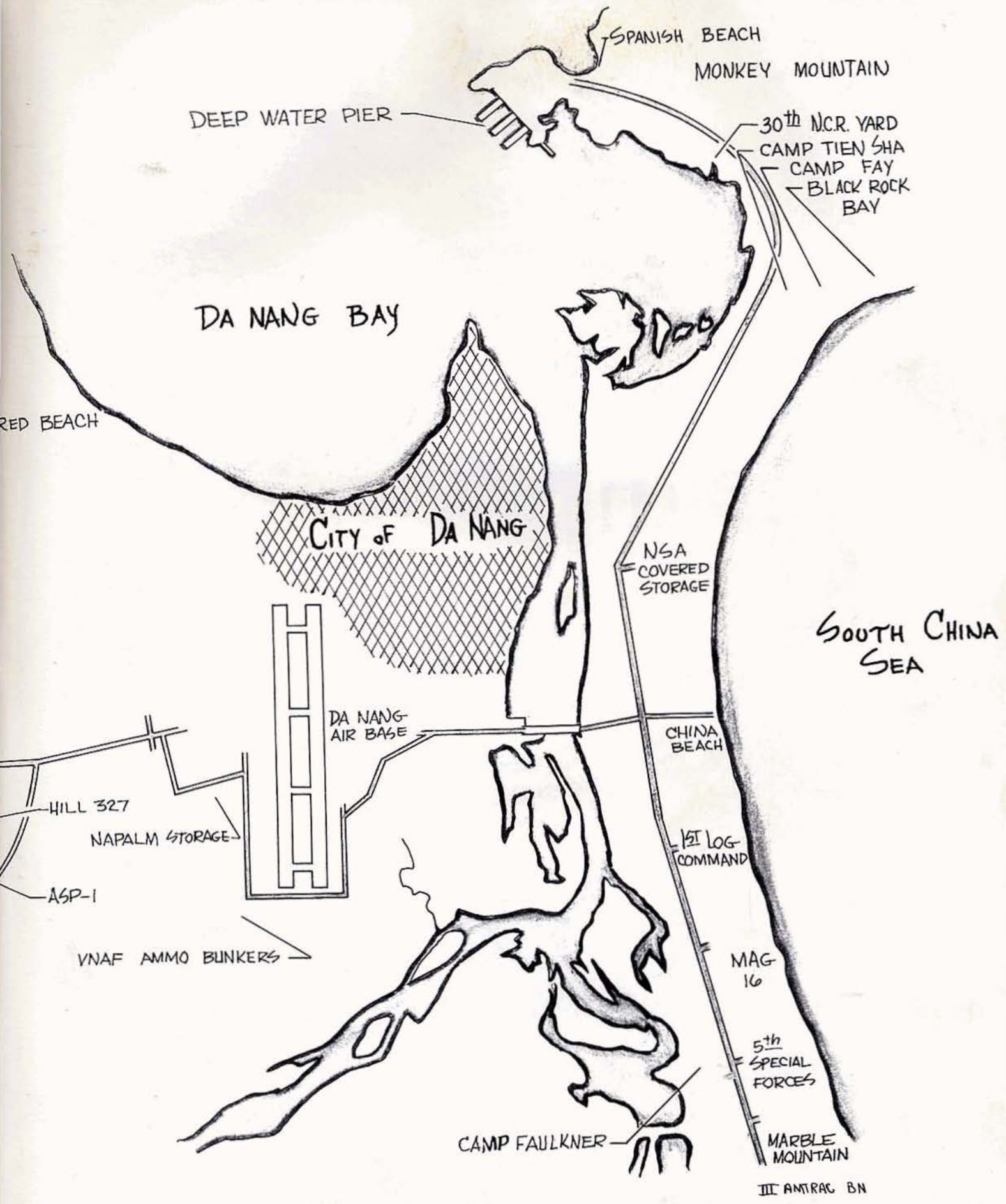

THE 133RD U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION WAS FORMED AND ACTIVATED ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1943, AT CAMP PERRY, WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA. ON SEPTEMBER 21, THE BATTALION MOVED TO CAMP ENDICOTT, DAVISVILLE, RHODE ISLAND, WHERE THEY UNDERWENT ADVANCED COMBAT AND TECHNICAL TRAINING.

AFTER RECEIVING THEIR TRAINING IN RHODE ISLAND THE BATTALION MOVED TO CAMP HOLIDAY AT GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, FOR MORE TRAINING IN CONSTRUCTION, OFFENSIVE AND DEFENSIVE COMBAT, AND TECHNICAL TRAINING. IN FEBRUARY 1944 THE BATTALION MOVED TO PORT HUENEME, CALIFORNIA, FOR ADDITIONAL TRAINING WITH MORTARS, OBSTACLE COURSES, AND ON THE RIFLE RANGE.

THE FIRST OVERSEAS DEPLOYMENT FOR THE BATTALION CAME IN MAY 1944 WHEN THEY DEPARTED THE U.S. FOR THE HAWAIIAN ISLANDS. THEIR FIRST PROJECT WAS TO INCREASE THE AVIATION GASOLINE STORAGE TANKS TO A CAPACITY OF 500,000 GALLONS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY COMPLETED TWO SEAPLANE RAMPS, EIGHT FLOATING PIERS, FIVE AVIATION MATERIAL STORE HOUSES, MACHINE SHOPS, SEVERAL 250-MAN FRAME BARRACKS, A TWO-STORY 40 BY 100 FOOT QUONSET-HUT BARRACKS, AN OFFICERS' MESS, WAVES' QUARTERS, AND DID ADDITIONAL WORK ON THE LANDING FIELD.

IN NOVEMBER THE BATTALION BEGAN PREPARATIONS FOR THE COMING INVASION OF IWO JIMA. ON FEBRUARY 19, 1945, THE ASSAULT TOOK PLACE. THREE SEABEE UNITS WERE ASSIGNED TO THE MARINES: THE 31ST, 62ND, AND 133RD BATTALIONS.

AS SOON AS THE JAPANESE WERE DRIVEN FROM THEIR AIRSTRIPS, THE SEABEES WENT TO WORK AND IN JUST SEVEN DAYS, THE NORTHEAST-SOUTHWEST RUNWAY HAD BEEN MADE OPERATIONAL AND WAS IN USE BY AMERICAN PLANES.

PROJECTS ASSIGNED TO THE 133RD WERE COMPLETED AT A RAPID RATE DURING THE NEXT FIVE MONTHS ON THE ISLAND.

WITH THE END OF HOSTILITIES, THE 133RD WAS DEACTIVATED IN DECEMBER 1945. AT THAT TIME THE BATTALION RECEIVED THE NAVY UNIT COMMENDATION MEDAL FOR THE PART IT PLAYED AS A SUPPORT UNIT OF THE 5TH AMPHIBIOUS CORPS DURING THE ASSAULT LANDING ON IWO JIMA FROM 19 TO 28 FEBRUARY 1945.

U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE WAS RECOMMISSIONED ON AUGUST 12, 1966, AT CEREMONIES HELD ABOARD THE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION CENTER, GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI.

COMMANDER E. H. MARSH, CEC, USN, ACCEPTED THE BATTALION FLAG FROM VADM LOT ENSEY, THE COMMISSIONING OFFICER AND THE NAVY UNIT COMMENDATION PENNANT FROM RADM W. M. ENGER, CEC, USN, DEPUTY CHIEF OF CIVIL ENGINEERS.

SINCE ITS COMMISSIONING, THE BATTALION HAS UNDERGONE MILITARY AND TECHNICAL TRAINING AT GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AND ABOARD KEESLER AIR FORCE BASE, BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI. ADVANCED MILITARY TRAINING WAS RECEIVED AT CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA, DURING OCTOBER-NOVEMBER 1966.

FEBRUARY 1967 SAW THE NEW 133RD IN DA NANG, REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM, MARKING THE BATTALION'S FIRST DEPLOYMENT SINCE WORLD WAR II.

THIS CRUISEBOOK IS ANOTHER PROUD CHAPTER IN THE HISTORY OF U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE. THE PICTURES HEREIN ARE PROUD REMINDERS OF THE OFFICERS AND MEN OF THE "CAN DO" SPIRIT.

The Story of 133 -

ALTHOUGH THIS BATTALION HAS BEEN IN COMMISSION FOR APPROXIMATELY 17 MONTHS (COMMISSIONING CEREMONIES WERE HELD 12 AUGUST 1966 AT THE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION CENTER, GULFPORT, MISS.), HUNDREDS OF HOURS OF WORK IN SELECTING PERSONNEL AND FORMING THE BATTALION'S NUCLEUS HAD BEEN INVESTED PRIOR TO COMMISSIONING. SOME OF THE FIRST MEN REPORTING FOR DUTY WITH THE FUTURE U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE ARRIVED AS EARLY AS MARCH AND APRIL OF 1966. MANY MAN HOURS WERE SPENT MERELY IN RECEIVING THE HUNDREDS OF NEW MEN REPORTING ABOARD, GETTING THEM ACCOMMODATED AND FORMING THEM INTO A UNIFIED UTIL-ARIAN GROUP. PRIOR TO ITS COMMISSIONING, U.S. NAVAL MOBILE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE WAS OVER A THOUSAND MEN STRONG; BUT, IN THE NORMAL ATTRITION PROCESS, THAT NUMBER WAS REDUCED TO 800 MEN -- AND PROBABLY THE FINEST UNIT ONE CAN FIND ANYWHERE.

AFTER THE RE-COMMISSIONING, THE BATTALION BECAME INVOLVED IN THE MANY ASPECTS OF BECOMING A TOTALLY PREPARED UNIT IN BOTH THE TECHNICAL AND MILITARY PHASES. MEN WERE SENT TO MILITARY AND TECHNICAL SCHOOLS, BOTH GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE; SOME WERE INVOLVED IN INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP TECHNICAL TRAINING; AND ALL PERSONNEL WENT THROUGH INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP MILITARY TRAINING, BEGINNING WITH ONE WEEK AT THE CENTER, TWO WEEKS AT KEESLER AIR FORCE BASE (ONE WEEK OF APPLIED MILITARY TRAINING AND ONE AT THE RIFLE RANGE) AND THREE WEEKS AT CAMP LEJEUNE MARINE CORPS BASE, NORTH CAROLINA.

UPON THE BATTALION'S RETURN TO CBC, GULFPORT, THERE WERE AGAIN MANY PHASES OF TRAINING SCHEDULED. IN THE EARLY PART OF DECEMBER, THE BATTALION HAD THE MOUNT-OUT EXERCISE INVOLVING LOADING AND OFFLOADING OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT ONTO AN LST.

ON 6 JANUARY 1967, THE ADVANCE PARTY LEFT GULFPORT FOR CAMP FAULKNER, LOCATED SOUTH EAST OF THE CITY OF DA NANG, VIETNAM, AND SITUATED ON A SAND DUNE ONE HALF MILE FROM THE BEACH OF THE SOUTH CHINA SEA, TO COMMENCE THE BATTALION EQUIPMENT EVALUATION PROGRAM OF THE EQUIPMENT THE RELIEVED BATTALION WOULD TURN OVER FOR OUR BATTALION'S USE. MOVEMENT OF THE MAIN BODY TO CAMP FAULKNER BEGAN 6 FEBRUARY. IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL, THE MEN WERE INDOCTRINATED INTO THEIR NEW JOB. THE TRANSITION FROM THE RELIEVED BATTALION TO NMCB-133 WAS VERY TRANQUIL.

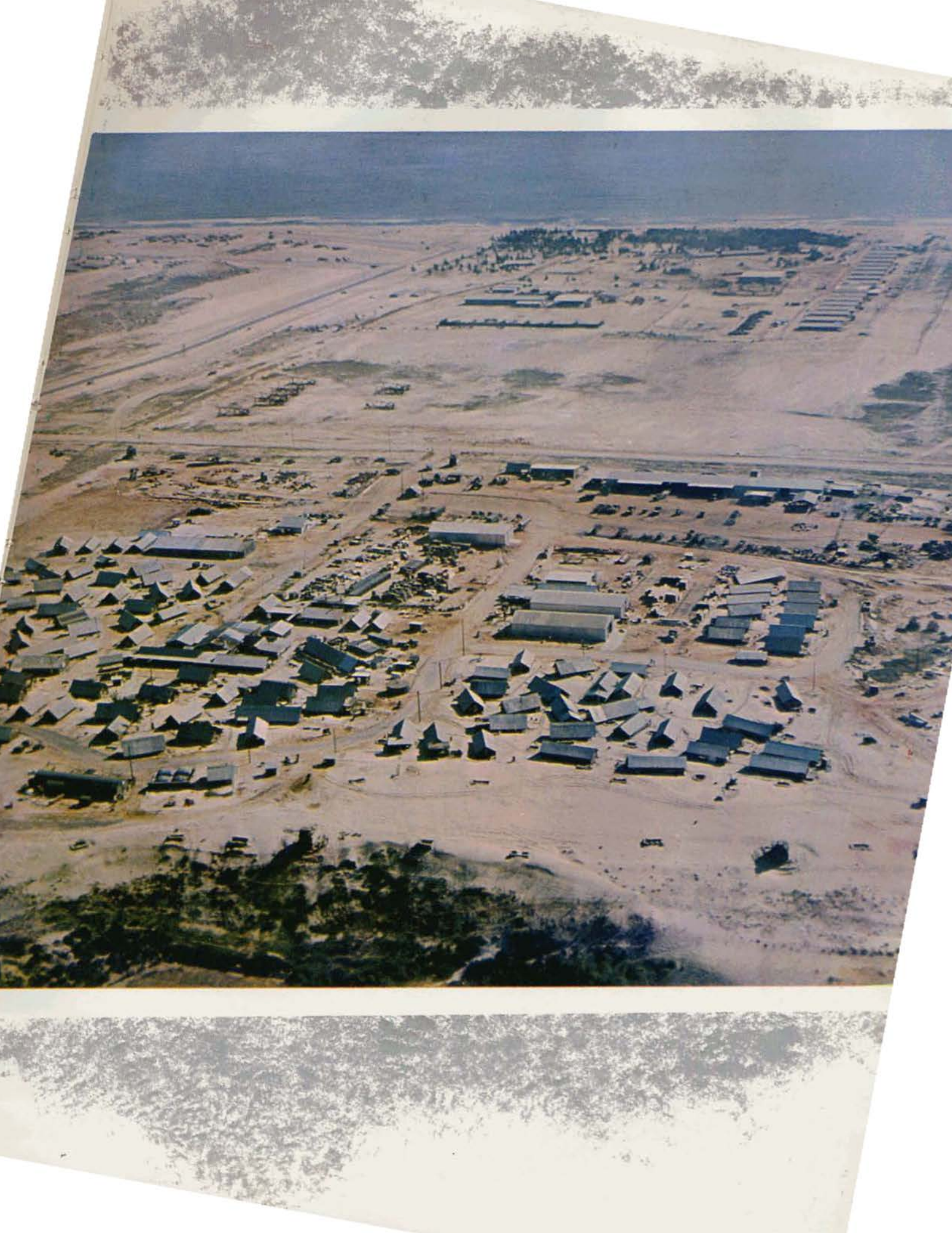

FT. IN CAMP FAULKNER, IMPROVEMENTS ACCOMPLISHED WERE ERECTION OF A PASCOE BUILDING; DRAINAGE MODIFICATIONS; STABILIZATION OF PERIMETER ROADS; IMPROVEMENTS IN PERIMETER BUNKERS AND FIGHTING HOLES; CONSTRUCTION OF SHELTER, WATER POINT AND LADDER TO RIVER FOR U.S. MARINES; PAINTING EXTERIOR OF ALL HUTS; RELOCATION OF P & E OFFICE; ADDITION TO PROJECTS MATERIALS OFFICE; FENCING OF MATERIAL YARDS; INSTALLATION OF TWO NEW 100 KW GENERATORS AND NEW COMMUNICATIONS AND POWER LINES; DRILLING A NEW WATER WELL AND CONSTRUCTION OF A STORAGE TANK; PLACEMENT OF A SECURITY FENCE AT THE ENLISTED MEN'S CLUB; NEW FURNITURE PLACED AND REDECORATION OF THE ENLISTED MEN'S CLUB AND ACEY-DUCEY CLUB; REMODELING OF GALLEY; IMPROVEMENTS TO CPO CLUB; CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW OFFICERS' CLUB AND FIRST-CLASS MESS; ADDITION TO ACEY-DUCEY CLUB AND ERECTION OF A FLAG-POLE AND CEREMONIAL CENTER.

THE BATTALION WAS ALSO INVOLVED IN CIVIC ACTION, WITH THE WORK PRIMARILY IN THE SUB-HAMLET OF SON THUY 1, DA NANG EAST, LOCATED OUTSIDE THE SOUTHERN PERIMETER OF CAMP FAULKNER. NEW HOUSES WERE BUILT AND OLD ONES REMODELED, DDT WAS SPRAYED ON A REGULAR BASIS, A NEW CIVIC ACTION CENTER, SWING SETS AND SEE-SAWS WERE ALSO CONSTRUCTED.

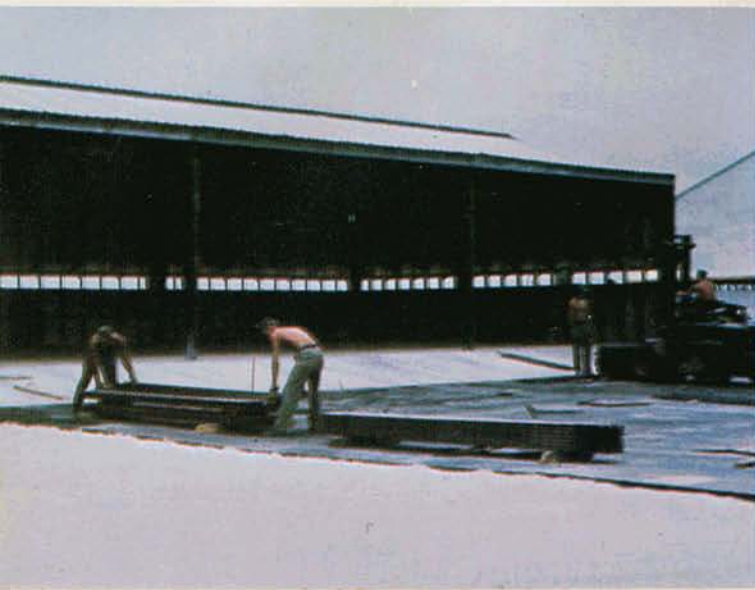
