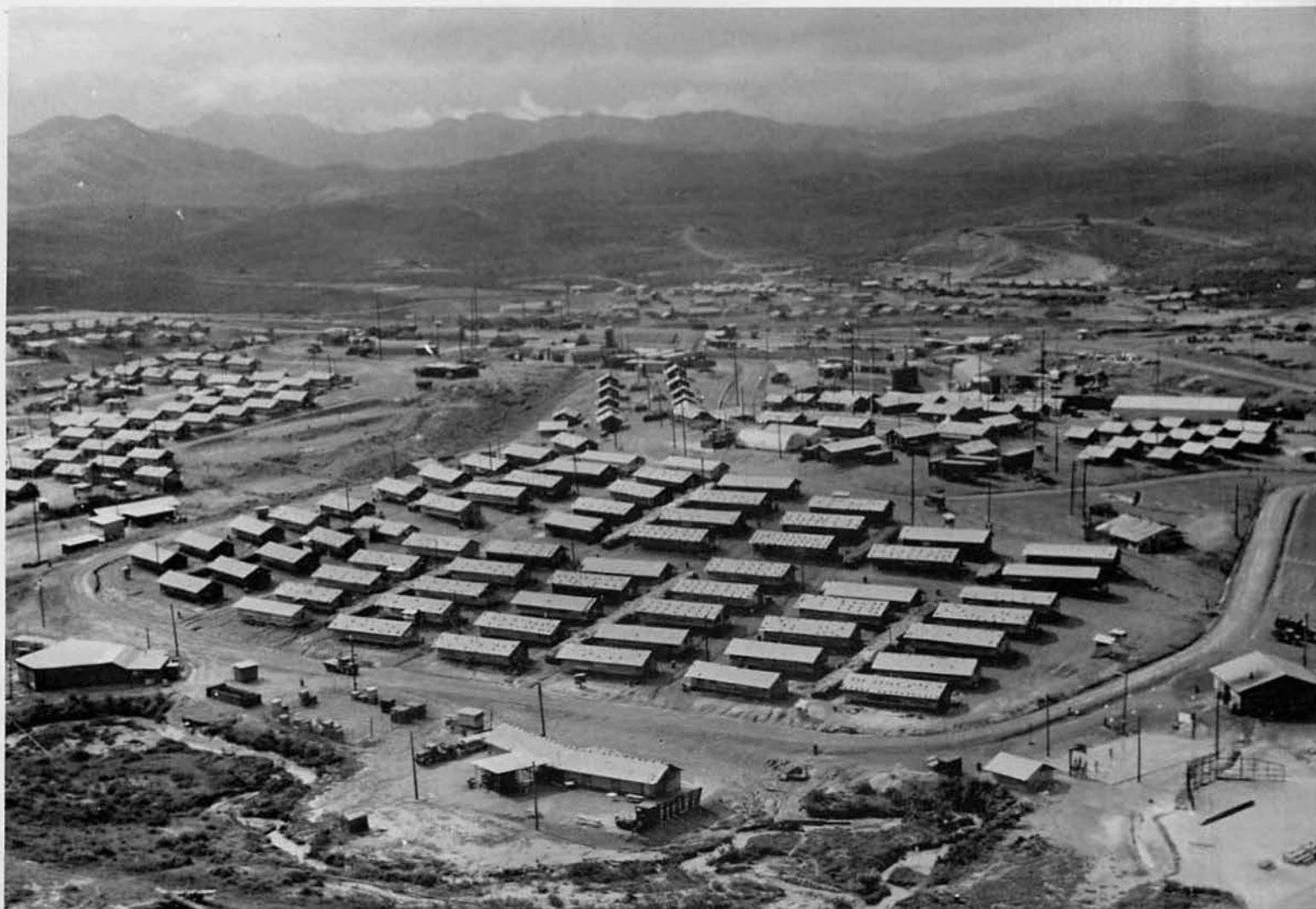


## In Memoriam

Builder Constructionman Ronald D. Tillery was killed August 17th when a 20 mm weapon was accidentally discharged from a nearby patrol boat. Petty Officer Tillery was serving on a detachment in the Delta when the mishap occurred.

On October 25th, Steelworker Third Class Joseph T. Wilson died in the Naval Hospital on Guam as a result of injuries received in an automobile accident. Petty Officer Wilson was serving as a member of MCB 133's Seabee Team 13304 on the Pacific Trust Island of Moen in the South Caroline chain at the time of the accident.

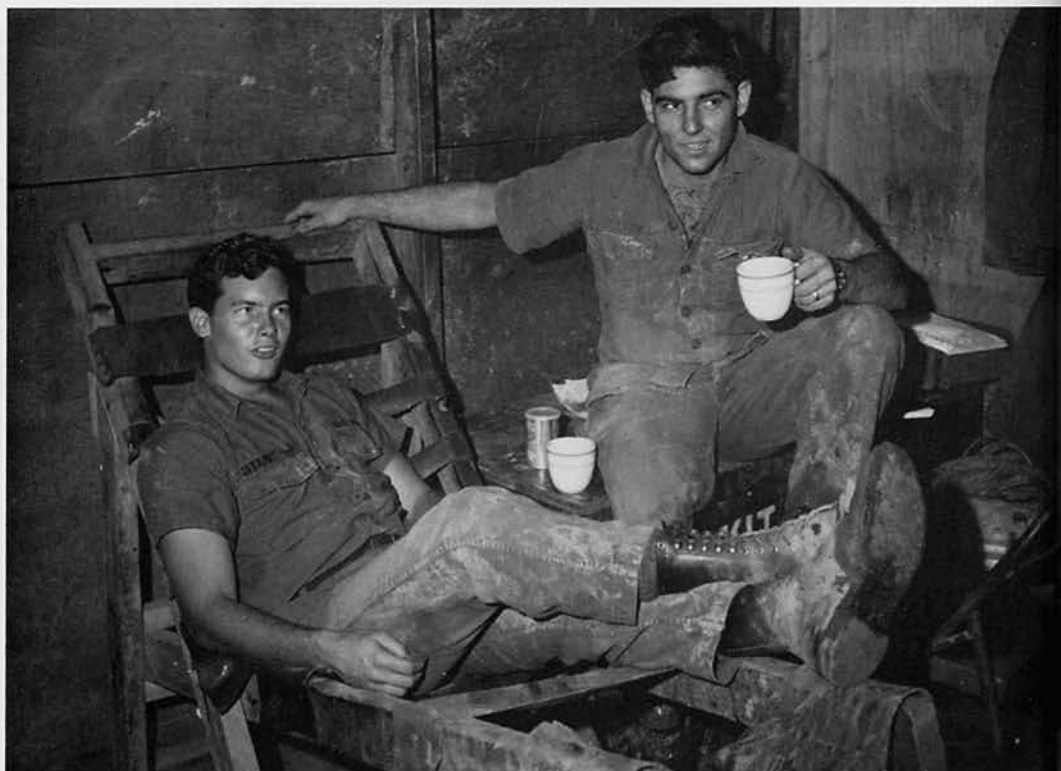

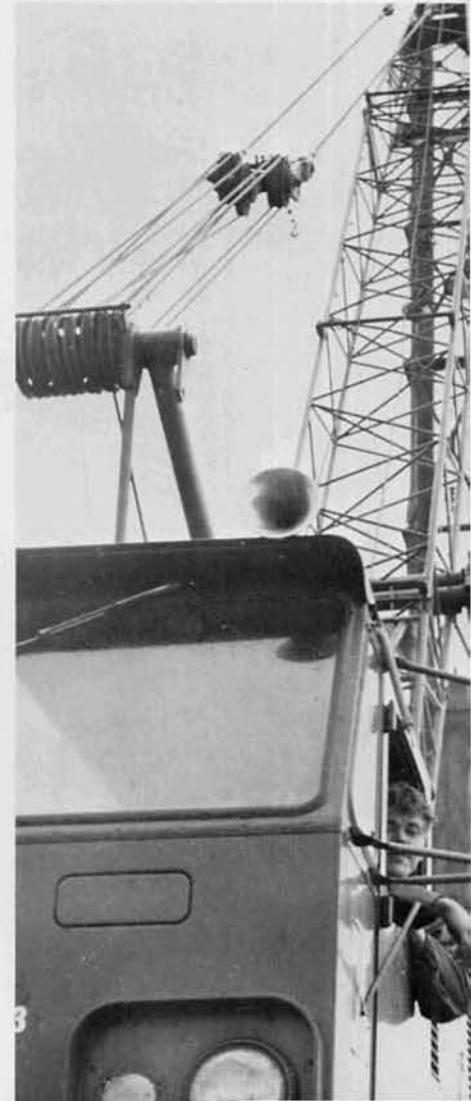

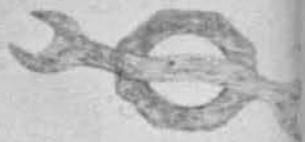
