



TASK ORGANIZATION: MCB SIXTY-TWO (Herein known as the Battalion)

1. SITUATION. Normal rotation of personnel within the Naval Construction Battalions requires a continuous training program to maintain the desired degree of readiness. Accordingly, it is necessary to move approximately 100 men of the Battalion from CBC Gulfport to the MARCORPBASE CAMLEJ in September 1966 for military training under the following conditions:

a. Enemy forces. None.

b. Friendly forces:

c. Detachment. 100 Man Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company to MCB FIFTY-EIGHT.

2. MISSION. Pursuant to reference (a), the Battalion is to deploy a Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company of approximately 100 men to CAMLEJ in conjunction with general military training and the use of crew-served weapons.

3. EXECUTION. When directed in September 1966, the Commanding Officer MCB SIXTY-TWO will deploy a Provisional Weapon/Rifle Company to CAMLEJ as an attachment to MCB FIFTY-EIGHT for a period of approximately four weeks. (While in transit and during training, the Company will maintain the same readiness condition as MCB SIXTY-TWO.)

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS:

a. Standard operational procedures, set forth by reference (b), will be followed.

b. Leave shall be administered in accordance with reference (c).

c. The Company will utilize Annexes A, B and C of reference (d) while it is under MCB FIFTY-EIGHT OPCON.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL:

a. The Commanding Officer, MCB SIXTY-TWO will direct the Officer-In-Charge, MCB SIXTY-TWO Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company to report to the Commanding Officer, MCB FIFTY-EIGHT on arrival at CAMLEJ for OPCON.

b. The Battalion is authorized direct liaison with MCB FIFTY-EIGHT, CAMLEJ, and component activities.
