TASK ORGANIZATION: U. S. Naval Mobile Construction Battalion SIXTY-TWO (Herein known as the Battalion)

1. SITUATION. In accordance with reference (a), the Battalion is undergoing a home-port training and organizational period. As part of this training, the Battalion will deploy a Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company of approximately 225 men to Camp Lejeune, North Carolina under the following conditions:

2. MISSION. Pursuant to reference (a), the Battalion is to deploy (a Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company of approximately 225 men) to Camp Lejeune in conjunction with general military training and the use of crew served weapons.

3. EXECUTION. When directed on or about 7 March 1970, the Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company will depart Gulfport, Mississippi and deploy to Camp Lejeune for approximately two weeks. While in training and during transit, the Company will maintain the same readiness conditions as MCB SIXTY-TWO.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS

- e. Convoy procedures as set forth in reference (k) will be followed.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL

- a. The Officer-in-Charge of MCB SIXTY-TWO Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company is hereby directed to report to CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune in accordance with Article 1324, U. S. Navy Regulations.
- b. Movement reports will be made in accordance with references (d) and (e).
- c. Submit requests to CG, MARCORBASE, Camp Lejeune for Communication Guard.
- d. Direct liaison is authorized with MARCORBASE and component activities.
