TASK ORGANIZATION:

U. S. Naval Mobile Construction Battalion SEVENTY-ONE

(Herein known as the Battalion)

1. <u>SITUATION</u>. In accordance with reference (a), the Battalion is undergoing a homeport training and organizational period. - 3. EXECUTION. When directed on or about 14 April 1969, the Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company will depart NAS Quonset Point, Rhode Island, and deploy to Camp Lejeune for approximately two weeks. While in training and during transit, the company will maintain the same readiness condition as MCB SEVENTY-ONE.
