1. (U) Command Organization

a. 1980 opened with Commander Joseph J. Dantone Jr., Commanding Fighter Squadron FOURTEEN, as the "TOPHATTERS" began workups for the upcoming Mediterranean deployment scheduled for 4 August 1980. On 22 December 1980, Commander Jack H. Hawver Jr., relieved Commander Dantone in a Change of Command Ceremony held onboard the USS JOHN F. KENNEDY (CV 67), while anchored in port at Naples, Italy.

b. The basic mission of the squadron has not changed; however, the emphasis in training has been shifted. As stated in the VF-14 Watch and Information Sheet, the mission of Fighter Squadron FOURTEEN is to intercept and destroy enemy aircraft and anti-ship cruise missiles in all weather conditions and to establish and maintain local air superiority. Historically, a fighter squadron is tasked with opposing enemy aircraft. However, with the threat of potent long range missiles in the enemy arsenal, the multi-track and ECM capabilities of the F-14A/AWG-9 Phoenix Weapons System have received added importance. Consequently, the Maritime Air Superiority role of the TOMCAT and its crew has received added emphasis. During 1980, VF-14 has continued training for both threats.

c. Command organization has remained consistent during the calendar year. Enclosure (3) presents a command structure as it existed throughout 1980 and lists the officers who held squadron billets at the close of the calendar year. Enclosures (7) and (8) provide a brief biography of the Commanding Officer and the Executive officer.

2. (C) Summary of Operations:

Calendar year 1980 was a highly successful and productive year for the TOPHATTERS. The first two months brought turnaround training to completion and began work-ups for a Mediterranean deployment with Carrier Air Wing ONE aboard the USS JOHN F. KENNEDY (CV 67). The squadron deployed aboard the KENNEDY on 4 August 1980. The cruise was filled with challenges and achievements, problems and solutions. In addition to normal piece time operations with various Allied and Sixth Fleet Units, real world intercepts against aircraft of third world countries became commonplace. While deployed, the squadron won the Silver Anchor Award and for the second consecutive time, was awarded the coveted Commander Naval Air Force, U. S. Atlantic Fleet, Battle "E" Award for 1980.

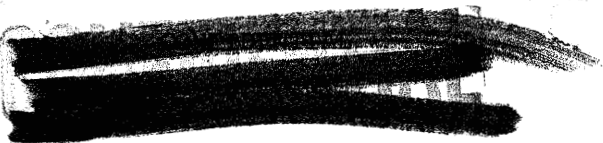
