COMMAND HISTORY USS JARRETT (FFG 33) CALENDAR YEAR 1998

1. Command Composition and Organization.

The mission of USS JARRETT (FFG 33) is to conduct worldwide prompt and sustained combat operations at sea, in support of national policy. The ship contributes to accomplishing the functions of sea control, with its lesser-included function of sea denial and projecting naval power from those areas under United States control. This FFG-7 Class Guided Missile Frigate is fully capable of operating as a member of a Carrier Battle Group, or assignment to protect an Amphibious Task Group, underway replenishment group or convoys, as well as conducting Maritime Interception Operations.

USS JARRETT (FFG 33), UIC R21058, is currently assigned to Destroyer Squadron Two One, and is commanded by CDR K. A. McGrath.

3. Summary of events.

During 1998, JARRETT was underway for 152 days. During the first five months of the year JARRETT prepared for deployment with the ABRAHAM LINCOLN Carrier Battle Group, and the ESSEX Amphibious Ready Group.

On 17 July 1998, as JARRETT got underway for deployment, a mishap in the anchor windlass room caused the anchor to let go. As a result, JARRETT's sonar dome was damaged, and the ship returned to port for repairs. On 24 June 1998, JARRETT was underway for deployment escorting the ESSEX Amphibious ready Group. During the transit to the Arabian Gulf, JARRETT Sailors enjoyed port visits to Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia, Singapore, and Phuket, Thailand.

After joining the Abraham Lincoln Carrier Battle Group JARRETT completed a successful Arabian Gulf deployment. While on station in the Arabian Gulf, JARRETT conducted 18 boardings of suspected United Nations Sanctions violators, and escorted numerous divert vessels to various Arabian Gulf countries.

JARRETT with the "BATTLECATS" of HSL FOUR THREE Detachment Two Encl(1)

embarked, returned from deployment along with USS ELLIOT (DD 967), and USS VALLEY FORGE (CG 50) on 07 December, 1998. This was JARRETT's seventh successful deployment since commissioning in 1983.

During the transit to San Diego, JARRETT enjoyed liberty port visits to Bali, Indonesia and Darwin, Australia. JARRETT stopped in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, where sailors embarked 22 family and friends for a "Tiger Cruise" during the transit from Pearl Harbor to San Diego.

On 18 December, 1998, CDR Kathleen A. McGrath relieved CDR Stuart O. Kendrick as JARRETT's Commanding Officer. CDR McGrath is JARRETT's twelth Commanding Officer. The year ended with the crew enjoying a well deserved holiday stand down.
