**COMMAND HISTORY
USS JARRETT (FFG 33)
CALENDAR YEAR 2001**

1. Command Composition and Organization

The mission of USS JARRETT (FFG 33) is to conduct worldwide prompt and sustained combat operations at sea, in support of national policy. The ship contributes to accomplishing the functions of sea control, with its lesser-included function of sea denial and projecting naval power from those areas until United States control. The FFG-7 Class Guided Missile Frigate is fully capable of operating as a member of a Carrier Battle Group, or assignment to protect an Amphibious Task Group, underway replenishment vessel or convoys.

USS JARRETT (FFG 33), UIC R21058, is currently assigned to Destroyer Squadron Two One. Commanded by CDR Clayton B. Kyker, the ship is homeported in San Diego, CA.

3. Summary of events.

During 2001, USS JARRETT (FFG 33) was underway for 119 days, meeting all commitments, and completing a compressed Inter Deployment Training Cycle to deploy two months early with the John C. Stennis Battle Group.

In the beginning of the year, after returning from holiday standdown, JARRETT completed a productive ten week Drydocking Ship's Repair Availability at South West Marine undergoing repairs, upgrades, and installations throughout the ship ranging from deck refurbishment to hull cleanings.

In late spring and early summer, JARRETT continued its up-keep, conducting three SIMA availabilities, a weapons onload, ATG Limited Training Team (LTT) visits, DLQs, CMTQ, and a very successful CART II.

At the end of the summer JARRETT rounded out its Basic Training Phase by completing the Engineering Underway Demonstration and Final Evaluation Period. Most of August was devoted to participation in the John C. Stennis Battle Group (JCSBG) COMPTUEX, the completion of a Combat Systems Groom in Port Hueneme, and an emergent drydocking to replace a damaged sonar dome. After completing COMPTUEX, JARRETT began preparations for JTFEX and deployment.

In the wake of terrorist attacks of September 11th, the decision was made to deploy the JCSBG with JARRETT two months ahead of schedule. JARRETT completed the final pre-deployment requirements with a successful MISSILEX with USS SIDES. Soon after, JARRETT conducted a short at sea training period with the JCSBG, rolling immediately into JTFEX. JTFEX training focused on support to Maritime and Leadership Interdiction Operations. JARRETT became part of the Sea Combat Commander's task force to locate and detain Al Qaeda attempting to utilize the sea lanes of the Arabian Sea. After spending 3 days inport San Diego, JARRETT deployed with JCSBG November 12th, Veteran's Day 2001 to the Western Pacific/Arabian Gulf in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

During the transit to the Arabian sea, JARRETT made a four day port visit to Hong Kong, a three day port visit to Singapore, and chopped to Fifth Fleet on December 15th to commence tasking in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

At the end of the year JARRETT had the good fortune to be inport Manama, Bahrain to celebrate the New Year with the officers and crew of the HMAS ADELAIDE, an Australian Navy Frigate, one of the Coalition Force partners.
