

#### BASIC NARRATIVE

On New Year's Day 1984 USS JUNEAU (LPD 10) was import San Diego, California, while her crew enjoyed a holiday leave period. JUNEAU was underway from 3-5 January for local operations, returning to port the evening of 5 January, where she remained until the 10th. The ship was again underway on 11 January, then returned to port where she remained until 16 January. On 17 January JUNEAU was underway for Seal Beach, where she arrived on 18 January, remaining there until 19 January for an ammunition off-load. JUNEAU returned to San Diego on the evening of 19 January.

JUNEAU then remained inport from 20 January through 11 March, undergoing a Planned Restricted Availability (PRAV). Major repair work and refurbishments were done throughout the ship. JUNEAU was underway for sea trials 12 March, returning pierside on the evening of 13 March. The ship remained inport until 19 March, when she was again underway for local operations until the evening of 23 March. The ship remained inport on 24 and 25 March, and was again underway from 26-28 March, arriving once again at Seal Beach on 29 March for an ammunition on-load, returning to San Diego on 30 March. There, she remained inport through 8 April.





JUNEAU was again underway in the SOCAL OPAREA from 9-12 April, followed by an inport period that lasted from 13-22 April. JUNEAU was underway from 23-26 April, then inport from 27-30 April.

The month of May began with JUNEAU underway, followed by an inport period from 3-7 May, then again underway from 8-9 May; inport 10-14 May; underway 15-18 May; inport from 19-22 May; and underway again from 30 May to 1 June.

The ship was inport from 2-17 June, as the crew prepared for the upcoming Refresher Training (REFTRA).

REFTRA began on 18 June as JUNEAU was underway until 22 June.

After a brief inport period, she returned to sea on 25 June,

completing REFTRA on 29 June. The ship then stayed inport from 30 June on through the Fourth of July.

JUNEAU was underway again on 5 and 6 July, and returned to port where she remained from 7-17 July. The ship was again underway on 18 and 19 July, then inport from 20-29 July, preparing for the upcoming Amphibious Refresher Training (PHIBREFTRA). PHIBREFTRA had JUNEAU underway from 30 July to 3 August, and again from 6-10 August. On 4 August the ship moored at Broadway Pier in downtown San Diego for a Visit Ship Weekend. While there, not only did a large number of the general public visit JUNEAU, but also



several hundred recruits from Recruit Training Command San Diego.

Following the successful completion of PHIBREFTRA,

JUNEAU was import from 11-15 August, returning to sea on 16
17 August. The ship was import briefly from 18-19 August,

and again underway from 20-22 August.

Following a brief inport period 23-24 August, JUNEAU, along with USS TRIPOLI (LPH 10) and USS MOUNT VERNON (LSD 39) participated in Exercise Kernel Usher 84-2 at White Beach, Camp Pendelton Marine Base. JUNEAU returned to port following this successful exercise on the evening of 31 August, to begin an inport period that lasted from 1-9 September.

JUNEAU was underway on 10 and 11 September, mooring to La Playa Pier on 12 September to on-load mogas. Later that same day she moved pierside at the Naval Station, remaining inport until 17 September. The ship was underway 18-19 September, then underway on 20 September for Seal Beach. She returned to San Diego on the evening of 21 September, where she remained inport until 11 October. On 12 October JUNEAU was underway for the afternoon, mooring pierside that same day, where she stayed until 17 October as JUNEAU's crew prepared for their upcoming deployment to the Western Pacific.





On 18 October JUNEAU departed NAVSTA San Diego with other ships from COMPHIBRON ONE for her ninth Western Pacific (WESTPAC) deployment. While en route JUNEAU was replenished by HMCS PROVIDER, a Canadian oiler. The long transit to Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, lasted until 27 October when JUNEAU arrived inport. She then on-loaded Marines from Brigade Service Support Group (BSSG) First Marines and was underway that evening.

On 28 and 29 October JUNEAU, along with MOUNT VERNON and USS MONTICELLO (LSD 33), anchored off Bellows Air Force Base at Waimanalo Bay for Exercise Rapid Support. JUNEAU weighed anchor on the morning of 30 October, pulling pierside that evening in Pearl Harbor. The crew then enjoyed liberty in Hawaii until 5 November, getting underway on 6 November for the transit to Yokohama, Japan.

JUNEAU arrived in Yokohama a day early on the morning of 18 November, due to a tropical storm, where she remained until 21 November. She on-loaded Battalion Landing Team (BLT) 2/6, and departed for Buckner Bay, Okinawa on the morning of 22 November. The ship arrived at Buckner Bay on 24 November and off-loaded BLT 2/6 and on-loaded BLT 2/9. She departed Buckner Bay on 26 November, en route Pohang, Republic of Korea. Upon arrival at Pohang on 28 November BLT 2/9 was off-loaded. JUNEAU was underway the following

morning en route Inchon, Korea, near Seoul, site of the 1988 Summer Olympic Games. JUNEAU passed through the locks at Inchon and moored pierside on 1 December, commencing a port visit that lasted until 3 December. JUNEAU was underway on 4 December, again en route Buckner Bay, arriving there on 6 December.

On 8 December JUNEAU was underway for Sasebo, Japan, where she arrived on 10 December for a month-long upkeep. There, the officers and men of USS JUNEAU celebrated Christmas and rang in the New Year Japanese-style, as the ship remained inport for the remainder of 1984.
