USS PONCE (LPD 15) Historical Narrative

PONCE commenced 1997 by completing holiday leave and upkeep period but rapidly escalated to her normal operational tempo. **PONCE** got underway for ISE operations in the VACAPES during which she conducted three burials at sea and successfully tested two prototype Rigid Hull Inflatable Boats. On January 31, 40 USMC Logistics Officer CSE students from EWTGLANT toured **PONCE**.

In February, **PONCE** conducted COMPTUEX with the 22nd MEU off the coast of Morehead City, NC. During this underway period **PONCE** hosted several PCOs for training. The engineering portion of their training was enhanced by an ETG assist visit. **PONCE** also conducted a close in rig dry refueling with USS Vicksburg (CG-69).

In March, **PONCE** conducted JTFEX 1-97 off Onslow Bay, North Carolina in preparation for deployment. On 29 April, **PONCE** got underway for her thirteenth Mediterranean deployment with embarked 22 MEU (SOC) elements. In May **PONCE** conducted OPERATION LINK SEAS with Spanish, Greek and Italian forces. After a port visit in Malaga, Spain, **PONCE** transitted to Almeria, Spain to conduct Exercise BETACOM with the 22nd MEU and units of the Spanish Foreign Legion.

At the end of May, 19 Midshipmen embarked from various commissioning sources for some excellent underway training, including OPERATION SILVER WAKE, an evacuation of 889 men, women and children from Albania, providing security for the elections, and Exercise "ALEXANDER THE GREAT" with the Greek Navy. At the end of a short port visit to Volos Bay, Greece, the Midshipmen departed and PONCE got underway for Pagasitikos Bay.

After the successful mid-June Training Amphibious Assault on Skiros Island, Greece, **PONCE** transitted the Turkish Straits enroute to the Black Sea to participate in Exercise "COOPERATIVE PARTNER" with units from the Greek, Dutch, German, Italian, French, Spanish, Bulgarian, Ukrainian, Rumanian, and Turkish Navies. Public relations efforts included a Bulgarian and Georgian tour with the embarked USMC.

Shortly after departing the Black Sea in July, the Mid-Cycle Assessment team arrived to assess PONCE'S engineering readiness. COMPHIBRON FOUR joined them for the last day's events, and both departed pleased with PONCE'S standard of excellence. During this same month, PONCE'S embarked SEAL team crossdecked to USS TEMPEST while PONCE became a key player in Exercise "ATLAS HINGE," conducting the second training Amphibious Assault of the deployment.

After a lengthy port visit in Corfu, Greece, **PONCE** again transitted the Turkish Straits back to the Black Sea to

participate in Exercise "RESCUE EAGLE" with Romania. In mid-August, **PONCE** honored the Romanian Navy Day with an impressive ceremony, and opened the ship for general visiting. Exercise "SEA BREEZE" was conducted at the end of August with the Ukranian Navy, USS SPRUANCE and USS CYCLONE, including anchoring at Donosluv, Pivdenny, and Odessa, Ukraine. **PONCE'S** Commanding Officer had the distinct pleasure of dining with the Ukrainian Chief of Naval Operations.

In September, **PONCE** transitted back to the Mediterranean for a port visit to Rhodes, Greece, followed by OPERATION HUMIDOR, including tactical maneuvering training with USS HUE CITY, and USS TEMPEST. Later in the month, **PONCE** embarked COMPHIBRON FOUR, 22 MEU, and media in support of Exercise "DYNAMIC MIX," a third training Amphibious Assault conducted with forces from the Spanish, Greek, and Italian Navies.

After a brief stop in Rota, Spain for turnover, PONCE outchopped from SIXTHFLT and inchopped with SECONDFLT to commence her transit across the Atlantic. After completing the offload of Marines and equipment at Morehead City, NC, PONCE was welcomed home by RADM Holder (CPG-2) and Commodore Ertel (CPR-4). Friends and family of crewmembers embarked for a "Tiger Cruise" back to Norfolk, VA. Throughout the deployment, PONCE displayed the professionalism and adherence to the highest standards of excellence which highlight her nickname "The Proud Lion."


