1. Attention is invited to an error in reference (a) and reference (b) where this Station is charged with ten seaplanes.

2. As reported in reference (c), this Station should have been charged with six seaplanes for week ending November 24, and as reported in reference (d) with five seaplanes for week ending December 1, unless this Station is being charged with the three flying boats, (A-752, A-753 and A-754) which were received from Bay Shore, in a condition beyond the capacity of this Station to repair.

3. If it was intended to charge these flying boats to this Station, the total number of seaplanes should have been nine and eight respectively.
